Graduation Photographs:

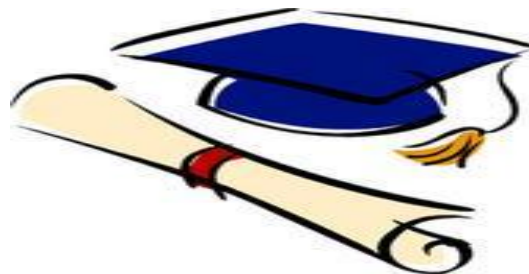
Wednesday 6th July
