Could we ask parents to make sure your child has got a hat, scarf and gloves at nursery so the children can be wrapped up nice and warm whilst accessing the garden.

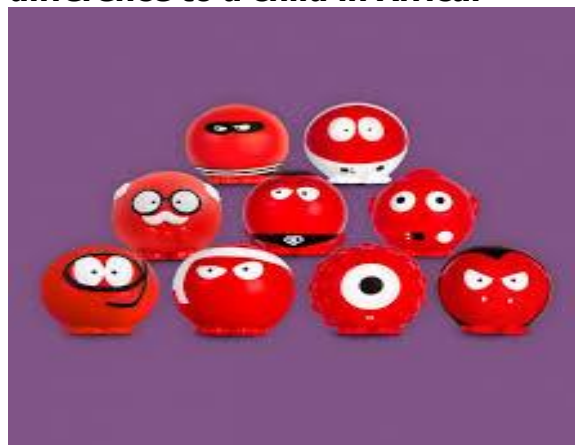
Nappies and wipes
