Graduation Photographs:

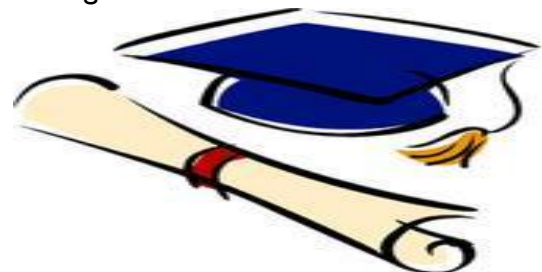
Wednesday 29th June.
