Could you provide your child with labeled slippers to wear indoors, we are constantly cleaning the carpets and would to keep the floor healthy and clean for your child to play on.

we are asking parents to please remove their shoes or wear foot covers provided at nursery before entering, the children are crawling around the floor and we would like to keep it as clean as possible. we do clean the carpets weekly thank you

Children's bags

We are finding that more and more parents are leaving antibiotics, calpol etc in their children's bags. can we please ask that if your child needs medication at nursery you speak to the staff directly and fill out a medication form. please can you also only provide what the child may need that day in their bags and nothing else.

Reminders

- Once again car parking is an issue, can we remind everyone to park correctly.
- If your child brings nappies in per day please can we ask that you put enough in to cover them for their session. Also the staff are experiencing lots of parents not bringing in nappies/ wipes or cream when been asked by a staff member. please can we stress to you we are only asking because your child has none left.
- Can we still remind you that breakfast finishes at 8.30 we are experiencing a lot of people coming in requesting their child to have breakfast after 8.30.
- Nursery closes at 6pm, we are experiencing more and more parents arriving late on regular occasions. the late collection charge is now £10.00 per ½ hour.
- Please can we ask that if your child has any marks, bruises, cut, grazes etc before they come to nursery, please can you inform the staff on arrival so the staff can fill out an existing injury form, this will save you getting a phone call at work. This is really important.
- Please can children not bring in toys from home.
- Security for your child and staff security can you please ensure you do not let anyone in that may be standing behind you. Everyone must come into nursery on their own password, even if you are dropping a pushchair of you must ring the door bell and do not enter behind anyone else.
- can we ask that you do not use or bring your mobile phones into nursery, this is a safeguarding nursery policy to protect the children and staff
- Please ensure your contact details are up to date, especially changes to any mobile numbers. Please inform the office
- if your child is not in nursery for any reason please can you inform nursery by 9am.
- Squirrels parents- when dropping of your child and collecting at lunchtime, please can we ask that you ring the doorbell and not the buzzer, this will help the children who are sleeping to get their full rest and not be interrupted.
