#### **Reminders**

- If your child brings nappies in per day please can we ask that you put enough in to cover them for their session. Also the staff are experiencing lots of parents not bringing in nappies/ wipes or cream when been asked by a staff member. please can we stress to you we are only asking because your child has none left.
- Nursery closes at 6pm, we are experiencing more and more parents arriving late on regular occasions. the late collection charge is now £5.00 every 15 minutes .
- Please can we ask that if your child has any marks, bruises, cut, grazes etc before they come to nursery, please can you inform the staff on arrival so the staff can fill out an existing injury form, this will save you getting a phone call at work. This is really important.
- Please can children not bring in toys from home.
- Security for your child and staff security can you please ensure you do not let anyone in that may be standing behind you. Everyone must come into nursery on their own password, even if you are dropping a pushchair of you must ring the door bell and do not enter behind anyone else.
- can we ask that you do not use or bring your mobile phones into nursery, this is a safeguarding nursery policy to protect the children and staff
- Please ensure your contact details are up to date, especially changes to any mobile numbers. Please inform the office
- if your child is not in nursery for any reason please can you inform nursery by 9am.
- We are no smoking area, please can you not smoke on our car park.

## Please can you not put medication in the children's bags.

if you have medication in the bags please can you remove them before they come to nursery or tell a staff member who will remove the items and put them in the medication box.
